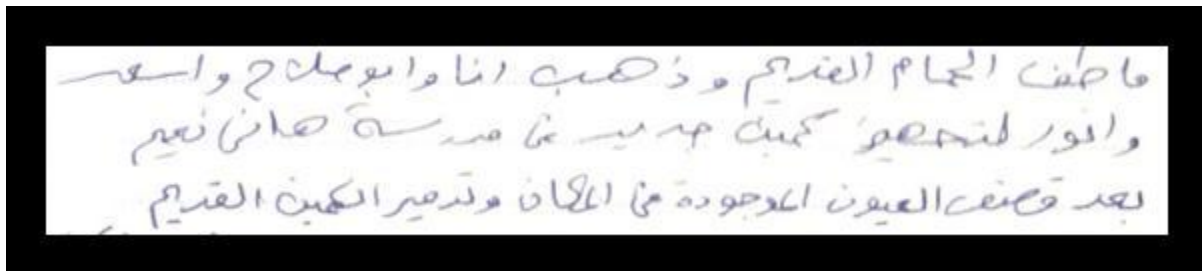


Sections From the Journal of a Platoon Commander in the Beit Hanoun Battalion

On 19.8.25, in the battalion commander's underground tunnel route in Beit Hanoun ("Tunnel Route 13"), the journal of a platoon commander in Hamas' 3rd Company of the Beit Hanoun Battalion, Khaled Abu Akram, was found. The journal contains quotes indicating details about the terrorists' lives underground and Hamas' exploitation of civilian infrastructures.

Below is a collection of excerpts and quotes from the journal, presenting Hamas terrorists' use of civilian infrastructures for terror purposes.

1. Written in the terrorist's journal on 30 May 2024: "I went with Abu-Saleh (a platoon commander in the 3rd Company of Beit Hanoun), Asaad, and Anwar to prepare a new ambush in the Al-Hani Naeem school, after the tunnel shafts in the area were struck and the previous ambush was disrupted."



2. Written in the terrorist's journal on 17 August 2024: "In addition, we planted an F-16 missile, anti-personnel explosive devices, and installed cameras in several places in the Al-Maftah area (literally: 'the key'). In addition, we removed the batteries from the UNRWA clinic, removed the solar panels, and prepared a water well."

The writer describes that they installed cameras in several places, removed batteries from the UNRWA clinic, removed solar panels, and prepared a water well as well as installing water pipes. He also describes that a new terrorist cell was established in the Dimra area under the command of Abu-Yahya, and that he received reinforcement from two operatives — Raghb Al-Kafarneh and Mahmoud Al-Za'anin.

3. Written in the terrorist's journal on 7 November 2024: "A few days ago, we installed an electric cable from the hospital to our house in order to operate our water well, but after a long time the well did not work. We thought maybe the electricity might be insufficient... We used the electricity from the hospital; the water rose but was weak. We brought a motor, operated it, and the water rose properly."

The writer documented that a few days earlier, on Thursday, 7.11.2024, he and his partners installed an electric cable from the hospital to their house in order to operate their well.

4. Written in the terrorist's journal on 7 July 2025: "I went to the school, the excavator began destroying (the structure) in the school. The time was 03:00 at night, an F-16 missile was planted in the school, but the cameras broke. When the tank was above the missile, they began the preparations."

These quotes show clear evidence, in the terrorist's own handwriting, that the Hamas terror organization uses civilian infrastructure for prolonged periods for terror purposes against IDF troops. Hamas terrorists do not hesitate to use any means to build and maintain their terror infrastructures, and use electricity supply, space, and energy from hospitals, schools, and UNRWA buildings. In addition, this is further proof that UNRWA serves as an infrastructure for the Hamas terror organization for strengthening and ongoing maintenance during the war.
